The Honourable Prime Minister of India expects your presence without fail at the National Security Council meeting scheduled for April 10, 2006.

The Meeting shall be held at the Prime Minister's Office at 1000 hours on April 10, 2006.

The broader agenda of the meeting is as follows:

- 1. Review the progress in investigating the Ahmedabad Railway Station bombings in February and multiple bombings in Varanasi in early March of this year.
- 2. Reviewing, Assessing and Preempting the overall National Security Threat perception both from domestic and international threats.
- 3. Routine Intelligence briefings about Domestic and International actors / threats.
- 4. Reviewing the Security apparatus for the State Assembly General Elections that will conclude tomorrow in Assam and the upcoming elections in Kerala, Tamil Nadu, West Bengal and Puducherry.

Kindly ensure to come prepared with all required material on the given agenda points without fail. Also note that an additional information docket shall be made available few hours prior to the scheduled meeting.
